



Launching of T.I.M.E. Alumni Association

(Paris, October 24th, 2013) – The Top Industrial Managers for Europe (T.I.M.E.) Alumni Association will be officially launched on October 26th, in Milan (Italy). The event will take place in conjunction with the General Assembly of T.I.M.E. association in the presence of Ecole Centrale Paris representatives such as Pr. Hervé Biauxser, President of Centrale Paris and Supélec.

T.I.M.E. graduates are, after this education, able to work transnationally and in trans-cultural environments.

The TIME Program is part of Centrale Paris' international strategy that aims to internationalize recruitment by opening up the educational program to students from industrialized countries, to offer its students the possibility of following degree courses in other countries and affirm the recognition of the quality of a degree from the Ecole Centrale Paris as one of the best in Europe and in the World.
